(NEW BEDFORD & DARTMOUTH RESIDENTS ONLY)

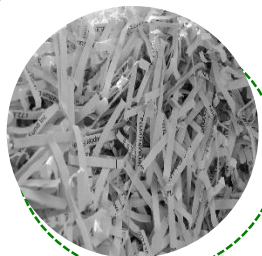
Location: New Bedford Transfer Station, 1103 Shawmut Avenue

Cash or check only. Tires 28.5 inches or taller = truck categories.

No commercial loads. Event is for households only.

Details: Examples of household hazardous wastes accepted: oil-based paints, paint thinner, & waste fuels. Maximum load size is 25 pounds or 25 gallons. Event is for households only. No latex paint; dry out and throw away in the regular trash.
