Fees: \$1 per car tire, \$5 per light duty truck tire, \$15 per heavy duty truck tire (max R24, no off-road equipment tires)

Cash or check only. Tires 28.5 inches or taller = truck categories. No commercial loads. Event is for households only.

Location: Crapo Hill Landfill, 300 Samuel Barnet Blvd, New Bedford; visit gnbrmdistrict.org for directions

Examples of household hazardous wastes accepted: oil-based paints, paint thinner, & waste fuels. Maximum load size is 25 pounds or 25 gallons. Event is for households only. No latex paint; dry out and throw away in the regular trash.
