IMMEDIATE OPENING FOR A MECHANIC/LANDFILL GAS TECHNICIAN

Join a mission-driven team keeping the Crapo Hill Landfill and its landfill-gas-to-energy system running safely and efficiently. You'll perform diagnostics, repair, and preventive maintenance on diesel and gasoline equipment and landfill gas and leachate systems. Mostly outdoor, hands-on work alongside our Lead Mechanic/Landfill Gas Technician. We're a progressive public entity serving New Bedford and Dartmouth, committed to environmental stewardship, public service and employee wellbeing.

What you'll do

- Assist in fabricating, installing, maintaining, monitoring and repairing the landfill gas collection system for optimal collection efficiency and environmental control.
- Assist in repairing, monitoring, and fabrication and installation of the leachate collection system.
- Diagnose and repair diesel and gasoline engines and heavy equipment, hydraulics, electrical, etc.
- Perform complex repairs, preventive and routine maintenance, keep service records, support availability and safe operations in the field and shop, and perform all other related work, as required.
- Perform welding and prefabricate parts, as needed, for dump trucks, loaders, tractors, compactor, sweeper, excavators, front end loaders, snow plows, and other equipment.
- Operate heavy equipment used in landfill operations.

What you bring

- Experience repairing both gasoline and diesel engines
- Technical high school diploma or equivalent hands-on experience.
- Strong mechanical, diagnostic, and problem-solving skills; self-starter.
- MA Hoisting Engineer License – Class 2A (or ability to obtain).
- Valid driver's license and acceptable driving record.
- Experience with gas and electric welding are preferred.
- Landfill gas/leachate experience is a plus.
